





## Bunho

The art of bunho involves the construction of furniture using the straw of the bunho plant, which is abundant in the central regions of Portugal. The artisanal process includes gathering, drying, and weaving the fibers, giving the final result lightness, durability, and comfort.





The craftsmen, known as "bunheiros", typically work seated and employ specific techniques, such as forming spirals called "caracol" or "chouriço." The work is demanding and requires careful attention to the moisture of the fibers, ensuring the quality of the furniture.
